2.Earlier when the matter came up for hearing on 12.09.2017, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that the petitioner has failed to comply with the condition from 22.07.2017 to 07.08.2017. Hence, the petitioner was directed to file a petition to condone the absence of the above



said days and also directed him to continue to comply with the earlier condition. Accordingly, a petition in CrI.O.P.(MD)No.8585 of 2017 is filed to condone the absence.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner is complying with the conditions till 07.08.2017 without fail and investigation has not been completed.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the nature of charges, the earlier condition is relaxed and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent Police as and when required only on receipt of summons. These petitions are ordered accordingly
