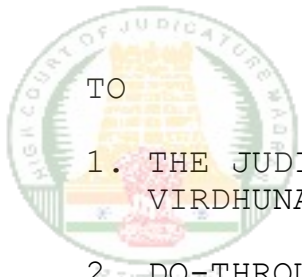
Heard both side.
