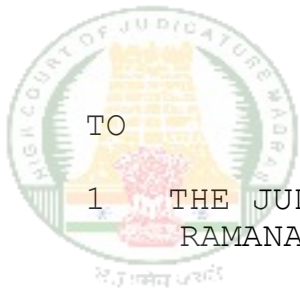
Heard Both sides.
