Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

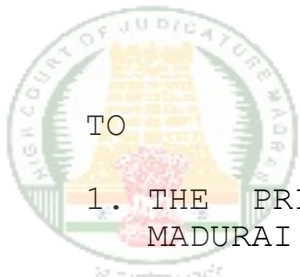
2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police submitted that the petitioner has complied the conditions imposed by this Court only for 16 days.
