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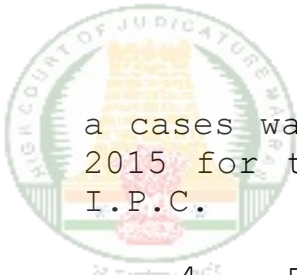
### **O R D E R**

a cases was registered by the second respondent in Crime no.23 of 2015 for the offences under Sections 406, 420, 294(b) and 506(i) I.P.C.
