PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

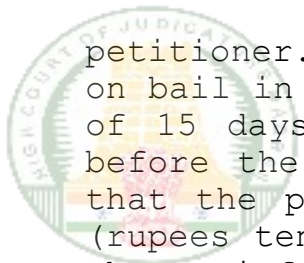
The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(i) IPC in Crime No.1087 of 2017 on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to some dispute, the petitioner attacked the de facto complainant with key of a two wheeler and caused injury.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent Police on instruction would submit that the petitioner is the sole accused and it is a case of case in counter and the counter case has been registered in Crime No.1088 of 2017. He further submitted that injured was discharged from the hospital and investigation is pending.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the fact that injured was discharged from the hospital, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the



petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Trichy, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

[a]the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of 3 weeks and thereafter, as and when required.

[b]the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[c]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d]on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate / Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate / Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIR SCW 5560).
