PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

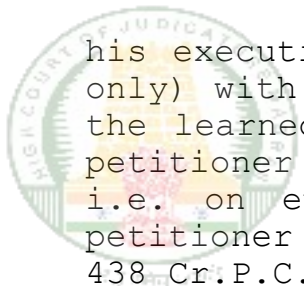
The petitioner, who is arrayed as Accused No.3, in Crime No.345 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 352, 353, 506(ii) IPC and Section 7(1)(a) of Criminal Law Amendment Act 2005 and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent/State.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent on instructions submitted that there are totally twenty one accused in this case and the allegation is that at the time of arresting A-1, A-2 and A-6 for causing disturbance to the public, the petitioner along with other accused restrained the police from moving the vehicle.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and due to previous motive, he has been falsely implicated in this case.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.III, Thoothukkudi and on



his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police once in a week i.e. on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
