PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/accused Nos.2 to 5, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.110 of 2017, on the file of the respondent police seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 27.08.2017, due to money dispute between the petitioner and the defacto complainant, there was a wordy quarrel arose between them and subsequently, the petitioners along with the other accused persons attacked the defacto complainant and caused severe injuries. On complaint, case has been registered on the same day for the above said offences.

3.The case of the petitioners is that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. It is a case and case in counter.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the injured person was discharged from the hospital.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Muthukulathoor, Ramnad District, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) each, with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(i) the petitioners shall report before the investigation officer, daily between 10.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m., for a period of two weeks;

(ii) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

(iii) the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation including custodial interrogation as and when required by the investigation officer;

(iv) the petitioners shall not commit any offence while on bail;

(iv) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.

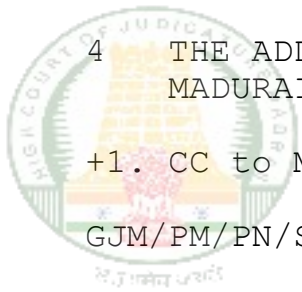
