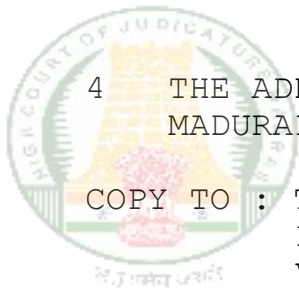
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offence punishable under Sections 307 and 379 IPC and Section 21(1) Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 r/w Section 3 of TNPPDL Act in Crime No.410 of 2017 on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent Police submitted that the petitioner is arrayed as A1 in this case and earlier the petitioner filed a petition in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.9962 of 2017 for anticipatory bail before this Court and this Court by order dated 02.08.2017 granted anticipatory bail by imposing certain conditions. However, the petitioner failed to comply with the said conditions and filed a petition in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.8159 of 2017 and the said petition was dismissed as it is was filed out of time. Now the petitioner filed the present petition for the second time seeking anticipatory bail on the very same set of facts.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner has admitted the above said facts.
