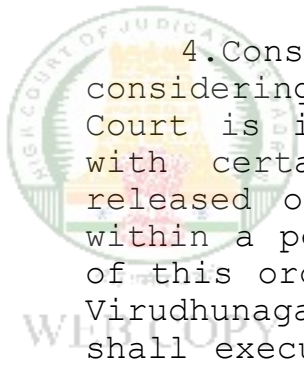
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as Accused Nos.1 to 9 & 12 to 14, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 323 and 506 (i) IPC in Crime No.493 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that there was a wordy quarrel between two groups of people in the same village and due to the same, the petitioners are said to have attacked the other group people by hands and caused injuries and the petitioners have also sustained injuries and they have also given counter complaint.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that there is no serious injury on the defacto complainant's side and all of them have treated as in patients and proceeding under Section 107 Cr.P.C has been initiated by the concerned Magistrate and the same is pending.



4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that this is a case and case in counter, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, they are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Sattur, Virudhunagar District on condition that each of the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(i) the petitioners shall report before the respondent police once in a week i.e on every Saturday at 10.30 a.m., and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

(ii) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

(iii) the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

(iv) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.
