PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners / accused Nos.5 to 24, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.364 of 2017 on the file of the respondent Police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are no way connected with the alleged offence and they are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the injured had already been discharged from the hospital. He further submitted that the investigation is yet to be completed and hence, he opposed for granting anticipatory bail.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the injured had already been discharged from the hospital, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manamadurai on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall report before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of one week and thereafter, the petitioners shall report before the respondent Police as and when required. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C., scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
