2.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondents.

3. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), the petitioner has given a complaint and the same is pending investigation.

Whatever might be the circumstances, there shall be no harassment to the petitioner, but let the police investigate into the matter in accordance with law and the mandates as found set out in D.K.Basu Vs.State of West Bengal reported in AIR (1997) SC 610. If really, the police want to interrogate, it is open for the police to issue summons to the petitioner. Thereupon, the petitioner shall appear before the police and submit himself for interrogation. The petitioner is also permitted to take the assistance of the Advocate to the limited extent as found envisaged in the precedent cited supra.

6. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
