Prayer : Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to direct the Principal District and Sessions Court(PCR), Ramanathapuram, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day to surrender on merits in Crime No.51 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police.

O R D E R

This petition has been filed, seeking to direct the Principal District and Sessions Court(PCR), Ramanathapuram, to accept the surrender of the petitioner and consider the bail application on the same day, on merits, in connection with the case in Crime No.51 of 2017.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 279, 337 and 204(b) and 506(i) IPC r/w. 3(i)(r)(s) of SC/ST (POA) 2015 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioner cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioner has come forward with the present petition for the said prayer.



3. Heard Mr.K.Anbarasan, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), who takes notice for the respondents.

4. Considering the submissions of both sides, this criminal original petition is disposed of with the following direction:-

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Principal District and Sessions Court(PCR), Ramanathapuram, within fifteen days from today and if they filed any bail application in this crime number, the Principal District and Sessions Court(PCR), Ramanathapuram, is directed to dispose of the application, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor, purely on merits and in accordance with law on the same day itself.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
