that the petitioners have been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 336, 427 and 506(ii) IPC r/w section 3(1)(r) and 3(1)(s) of SC & ST Act and



that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioners have come forward with the present petition for the said prayer.

3. Heard Mr.K.Anbarasan, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), who takes notice for the respondents.

4. Considering the submissions of both sides, this criminal original petition is disposed of with the following direction:-

The petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Principal District Judge (PCR), Ramanathapuram,, within fifteen days from today and if they filed any bail application in this crime number, the learned Principal District Judge (PCR), Ramanathapuram, is directed to dispose of the application, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor, purely on merits and in accordance with law on the same day itself.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
