2.The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 352, 506(ii) IPC r/w Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act POA 2015, in Crime No.1 of 2017 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioner cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioner has come forward with the present

Court), Thanjavur, within fifteen days from today and if he filed any bail application in this crime number, learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge, (PCR Court), Thanjavur, is directed to dispose of the application, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor, purely on merits and in accordance with law on the same day itself.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
