PRAYER: Criminal Original petition filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to direct the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge (Special Court for PCR Cases), Dindigul, to receive the bail petition and surrender petition in Crime No.530 of 2017 and consequently to direct the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge (Special Court for PCR Cases), Dindigul to fix the specific date or dates for hearing the respondents and the petitioner / accused and to dispose both the surrender and bail petitioner simultaneously on the same day on merits in accordance with law.

In view of the amendments made in the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes(Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, this Court is of the view that the usual directions that were issued by this Court cannot be issued routinely in all cases. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on such surrender, the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge (Special Court for PCR Cases), Dindigul, is directed to consider the bail petition filed by the petitioner in connection with Crime No.530 of 2017, on merits and in accordance



with law, after issuing notice to the victims under Section 15 (A) of the SC/ST Act.

2. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
