PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

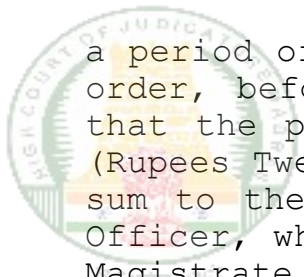
The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No. 1191 of 2017, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was a money dispute between the petitioner and the defacto complainant regarding the purchase the shirt, thereby the petitioner attacked the defacto complainant and he sustained injury.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent person and she has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that in fact a case in counter has been lodged by the petitioners herein against the defacto complainant.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State submitted that injured has been discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), that injured has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within



a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Melur, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

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- (i) the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police, as and when required;
- (ii) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;
- (iii) the petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail;
- (iv) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law and the anticipatory bail granted stands cancelled automatically.
