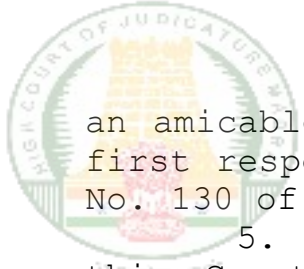
ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking to quash the F.I.R in Crime No. 130 of 2014 on the file of the 1st respondent/complainant.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the petitioner and the second respondent are present along with their counsel and their identifications were also verified by this Court, in addition to the confirmation of the identity of the parties by the learned Government Advocate (Cr1.Side) through the respondent police.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the second respondent would submit that the matter is now compromised out of the court.

4. Further, both parties filed a joint compromise memo, dated 17.02.2017 stating that since the parties have arrived at



an amicable settlement by way of compromise among themselves, the first respondent is not willing to proceed with the case in Crime No. 130 of 2014 on the file of the first respondent.

5. Hence, in view of affidavit and memo dated 17.02.2017, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in keeping the matter pending.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the entire proceedings in Crime No. 130 of 2014 on the file of the first respondent police, is hereby quashed.
