PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioner/accused, prays for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b) and 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.9 of 2017 on the file of the respondent

2. The case of the prosecution is that when the defacto complainant questioned about the quarrel, the petitioner and others abused and threatened him.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that none sustained injury in this case.

5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioner can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the



respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam, within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of the order,

(i) the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the likesum to their satisfaction;

(ii) the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police once in a week on every Monday at 10.30 a.m until further orders.
