**O R D E R**

This petition has been filed, seeking to direct the learned I Additional District & Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Thanjavur, to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day of their surrender in connection with the case in Crime No.64 of 2017 on the file of the respondents police.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) of IPC and section 3(1)(r), (s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST POA Act, in Crime No.64 of 2017 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioners have come forward with the present petition for the

4. Considering the submissions of both sides, this criminal original petition is disposed of with the following direction:-

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The petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned I Additional District & Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Thanjavur, within fifteen days from today and if they filed any bail application in this crime number, the learned I Additional District & Sessions Judge (PCR Court), Thanjavur, is directed to dispose of the application, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor, purely on merits and in accordance with law on the same day itself.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
