The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) on instructions, would submit that after investigation, FIR has been registered in Crime No.1471 of 2016, against the petitioner for the offences under Sections 387 and 506(ii) IPC., He further submitted that seven previous cases are pending against the present petitioner and the petitioner is a wanted accused by the respondent police.
