ORDER

3. Mr.P.Subburaj, Special Sub-Inspector of Police, Chinnamanoor Police Station, Theni District, is present in Court today. On instructions, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that, on the complaint given by second and third respondents, a petition enquiry in C.S.R.No.90 of 2017 is pending.

4. The petitioner is directed to participate in the enquiry and during enquiry, he shall not be harassed. During the course of



enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police is free to register an FIR and this order shall not be a shield for the petitioner against arrest.

5. With the above direction, this petition is closed.
