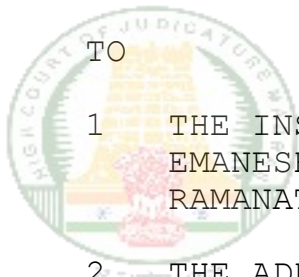
3.Recording the above submission of the learned Government Advocate, this criminal original petition is dismissed as infructuous.
