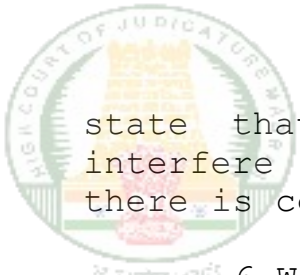
This petition has been filed seeking a direction to the 2nd Respondent Police not to interfere in the civil dispute and civil rights of the Petitioner.
