COMMON ORDER

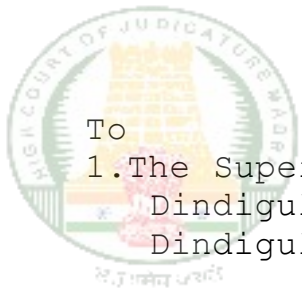
