PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

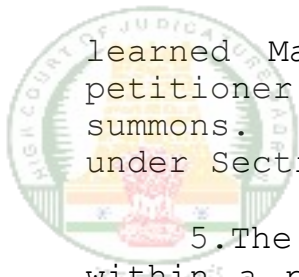
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A-3, in Crime No.21 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 of I.P.C @ 120(b), 406 and 420 of I.P.C and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) for the respondent/State.

3. The learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) on instructions submitted that the petitioner colluded with the other accused had withdrawn a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- belonged to the defacto complainant and had taken away the gold ornaments stating that they will return back the same. But, thereafter, they did not repay the said amount. Hence, the present complaint has been lodged. He further submitted that in this case investigation was completed and charge sheet was filed before the Court below in C.C.No.324 of 2016.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tirunelveli and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the



learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Court concerned on receipt of summons. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
