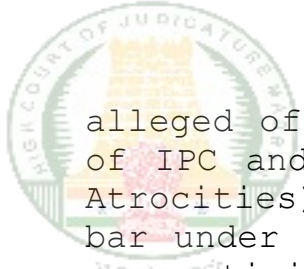

O R D E R

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have come forward with this petition seeking for a direction to the III Additional District and Sessions Judge (PCR), Madurai to consider the Bail application of the petitioners on the same date of surrender in Crime No.628 of 2016 on the file of the second respondent police.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners also submits that the petitioners have been implicated in this case for the



alleged offences under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 379 and 506(i) of IPC and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities), Amendment Act 2015 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the said Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioners have come forward with the said prayer.

3.Today, M/s.P.Manimegalai, Sub Inspector of Police, Usilampatti Town Police Station, Madurai is present before this Court.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) takes notice for the respondents and submitted that no one sustained injury in the alleged occurrence.

5.Considering the submissions of both sides and also considering the nature of the prayer in this case, in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the S.C. & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act that the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the III Additional District and Sessions Judge (PCR), Madurai, in respect of Crime No.628 of 2016 on the file of the second respondent police, within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on the petitioners' surrender and filing bail application in Crime No.628 of 2016, the III Additional District and Sessions Judge (PCR), Madurai, in turn, is directed to accept their surrender and consider their bail application on merits and in accordance with law on the same day.

6. With the above direction, this petition is disposed of.
