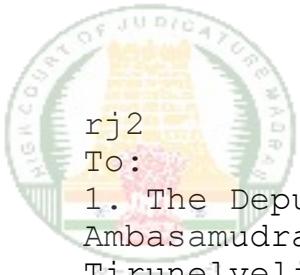
2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (crl. side) for the respondents.
