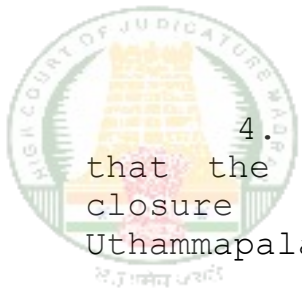
O R D E R

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) submitted that the investigation in Crime No.244/2017 was completed and closure report has been filed before the Tahsildar, Uthammapalayam.

Under such circumstances, the Tahsildar, Uthammapalayam, is directed to take photo copies of all the records submitted by the police and send the original records to the Judicial Magistrate, Uthammapalayam within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Liberty is given to the petitioner to file a protest application before the Judicial Magistrate, Uthammapalayam, within four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. A copy of the closure report has also been served on the learned counsel for the petitioner across the Bar.

6. With the above observation and direction, this petition is closed.
