This petition has been filed, seeking to direct the learned Principal District and Sessions Court (PCR Act cases), Ramanathapuram, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider their bail application on the same day on merits, in relating to Crime No.12 of 2017, on the file of the respondents police.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 294(b), 324, 307 IPC r/w 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of SC/ST (POA) Amendment Act, 2015, in Crime No.12 of 2017 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioners have come forward with the present petition for the said prayer.

The petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Principal District and Sessions Court (PCR Act cases), Ramanathapuram, within fifteen days from today and if they filed any bail application in this crime number, learned Principal District and Sessions Court (PCR Act cases), Ramanathapuram, is directed to dispose of the application, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor, purely on merits and in accordance with law on the same day itself.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
