This petition has been filed, seeking to the learned Principal Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for P.C.R. Cases, Sivagangai District, to consider the bail application of the petitioner/A7 if any filed by him on his surrender on the same day in Crime No.2 of 2017 on the file of the 2nd respondent.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 148, 341, 294(b) and 352 IPC and Sections 3(1)(r) & 3(1)(s) of SC/ST (POA) Amendment Act 2015, in Crime No.2 of 2017 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioner cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioner has come forward with the present petition for the said prayer.

3.Heard Mr.A.P.Balasubramani, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), who takes notice for the respondents.

4.Considering the submissions of both sides, this criminal original petition is disposed of with the following direction:-



The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Principal Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for P.C.R. Cases, Sivagangai District, within fifteen days from today and if they filed any bail application in this crime number, learned Principal Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for P.C.R. Cases, Sivagangai District, is directed to dispose of the application, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor, purely on merits and in accordance with law on the same day itself.

With this observation, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
