PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as sole accused, in Crime No.131 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 427 and 379(NP) of I.P.C and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

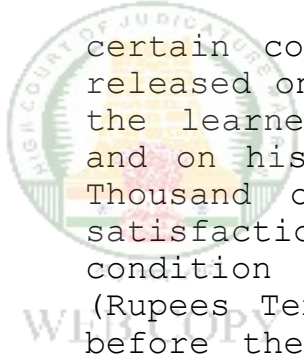
2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent/State.

3.The case of the prosecution is that due to wordy quarrel, the petitioner damaged the two-wheeler belonging to the defacto complainant.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he is nothing to do with the offence as alleged by the prosecution.

5.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor on instructions submitted that the petitioner damaged the two-wheeler belonging to the defacto complainant.

6.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with



certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pattukkottai, Thanjavur District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) to the credit of Crime No.131 of 2017 before the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
