PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused Nos.1 to 3 in Crime No.163 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 379 N.H. of IPC and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

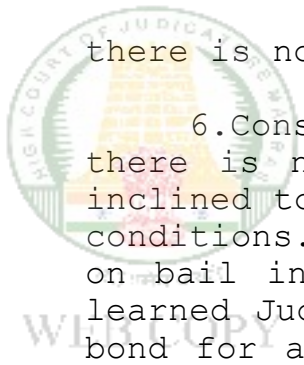
2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent/State.

3.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners illegally transported the river sand worth about Rs.2000/-.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have nothing to do with the alleged offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that only for statistical purpose, they have filed the present case.

5.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that



there is no previous case against the petitioners.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and that there is no previous case against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Mudhukulathur and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police once in a week i.e. on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders, for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
