Writ petition filed Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the Impugned Order passed by the 2nd Respondent in Proceedings No. 59, dated 19.06.2015 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondent 1 to 3 to approve the petitioner's name for undergoing one year industrial safety Diploma course with the 4th respondent.

ORDER:

In view of the dual stand taken by the writ petitioner one before the Chief Engineer and another by not informing the fact to the learned counsel appearing on his behalf in the High Court, under these circumstances, the Chief Engineer, Tuticorin Thermal Power Station is directed to inform the writ petitioner Mr.D.Nalladurai Charles to be present before this Court along with letter given by him and with the files tomorrow on 28.08.2019 at 10.30a.m., The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Board is directed to inform this order to the Chief Engineer, Tuticorin Thermal Power Station over phone and ensure the presence of the writ petitioner before this Court on 28.08.2019 at 10.30 a.m., with the permission of the Chief Engineer.
