He further submitted that on the basis of the complaint given by the defacto complainant, the petitioner is compelled to hand over huge quantity of gold jewels worth about several lakhs unnecessarily.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), on instructions, submitted that there is no harassmet in this case and the petitioner would not be called for enquiry without issuing
