2. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (crl.side) for the respondent.

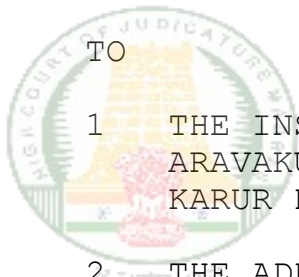
