O R D E R

This petition has been filed, seeking to direct the learned III Additional District and Sessions Court (PCR), Madurai,, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider their bail application on the same day on merits in connection with Crime No.47 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 506(i) IPC r/w section 3 (1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015, in Crime No.47 of 2017 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioners have come forward with the present petition for the said prayer.

4.Considering the submissions of both sides, this criminal original petition is disposed of with the following direction:-

The petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned III Additional District and Sessions Court (PCR), Madurai, within fifteen days from today and if they filed any bail application in this crime number, the learned III Additional District and Sessions Court (PCR), Madurai, is directed to dispose of the application, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor, purely on merits and in accordance with law on the same day itself.
