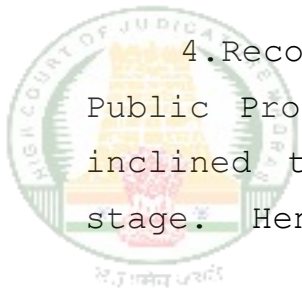
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 354(A), 506(i) of IPC in Crime No.Not Known of 2017 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent/State.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent states that no petition enquiry or FIR is pending, as against the petitioner and therefore, the alleged threat of arrest or harassment, as stated by the petitioner herein, is not true.



4. Recording the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, at this stage. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
