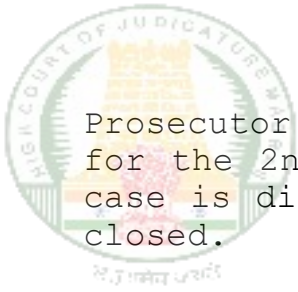
PRAYER: The Criminal Revision case is filed under Section 397 r/w 401 Cr.P.C., as against the judgment passed by the learned IV Additional District and Sessions Judge, Madurai dated 31.08.2017 in Criminal Appeal No.103 of 2016 in so far as it directs the petitioner / 1st respondent / accused herein to pay a sum of Rs.20,000/- as costs to the 2nd respondent / appellant / de facto complainant within 30 days from the date of receipt of the judgment and further ordered that on failure, the petitioner / 1st respondent / accused shall be sentenced to undergo imprisonment for a period of 30 days as mentioned in Section 359 Cr.P.C.
