





4. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petition to set aside the ex-parte order is pending from 26.08.2016 onwards and therefore, he prays for early disposal of the said petition.

5. Since a direction for early disposal of the petition is passed, no notice is necessary to the respondents herein.

6. Considering the fact that the petition to set aside the ex-parte order is pending from 26.08.2016 onwards, this Court feels that ends of justice would be met by directing the Court below to dispose of the same within a time frame. Without advertent to the merits of the case, a direction is issued to the learned Principal District Judge, Virudhunagar at Srivilliputtur, to dispose of I.A.No.249 of 2016 in O.S.No.59 of 2016 within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected C.M.P.(MD) No.9501 of 2017 is closed.
