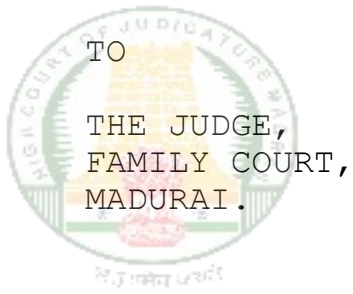
3.The learned Judge should keep in mind the attitude of the parties and dispose of the matter within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
