ORDER

The Civil Revision Petition is filed to set aside the fair and decreetal order of learned Sub Court, Virudhunagar in I.A.No.115 of 2016 in MCOP.No.46 of 2013, dated 21.04.2016, by which partly allowing the above said application, the dismissal of part prayer and allow this Civil Revision Petition.

2. This Civil Revision Petition is filed against the order permitting the petitioner to withdraw the portion of the amount deposited by the respondent.

3. According to the petitioner, the petitioner filed MCOP.No.46 of 2013, on the file of the Sub Court, Virudhunagar, claiming a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- for the injury caused to him in the accident took place on 12.05.2012. The Tribunal awarded a sum of Rs.2,60,197/- as compensation and directed the respondent, to deposit the amount awarded together with interest and cost and permitted the petitioner to withdraw interest and cost. Against the award of the Tribunal, the Transport Corporation did not file
