When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional public prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 would submit that the Petitioner came to know that the detinue since married to the third respondent and that she is a major. In fact, both the Petitioner and detinue met each other in Police station and when a request was made to his daughter, a scene was created, pursuant to which a case has been registered. Considering the above, we find that there is no illegal detention of the petitioner's daughter.



2. In view of the above, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands dismissed.
