Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

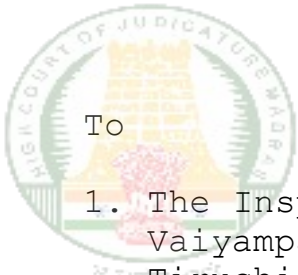
