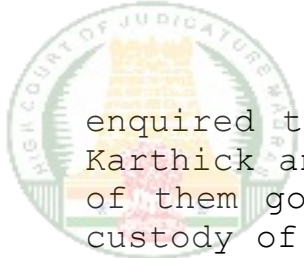
O R D E R

The present Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed by the brother of the detainee viz., Valarmathi, D/o.Radhakrishnan, aged about 23 years, stating that he is taking care of his sister-the detainee, who had completed M.Sc. (IT) Master Degree. While so, on 25.01.2017, the detainee was found missing and hence, he made a complaint to the respondents. However, no steps were taken to secure the detainee so far. Hence, the petitioner has come up with the present petition.
