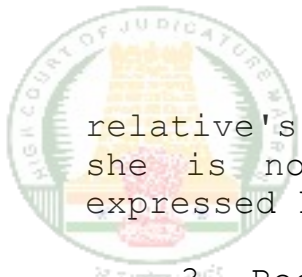

O R D E R

[Order of the Court was made by **R.SUBBIAH, J.**]

The petitioner, who is the mother of the detinue-Nagalakshmi, aged about 20 years, has filed the present Habeas Corpus Petition, stating that the detinue was found missing from 03.02.2017 onwards and in this regard, she has made a complaint before the second respondent on 04.02.2017. However, no effective steps were taken to trace out the detinue so far. Hence, the petitioner has come up with the present petition.

2. Today when the matter was taken up for consideration, the second respondent produced the detinue before this Court. On our enquiry, she told us that she was not allowed to study by her mother and hence, she voluntarily left the house and stayed in her



relative's house. Further, the detainee has assertively stated that she is not in illegal custody of anybody. Now, she has also expressed her willingness to go along with the petitioner.

3. Recording the submission made by the detainee, the Habeas Corpus Petition is closed as nothing survives for adjudication.
