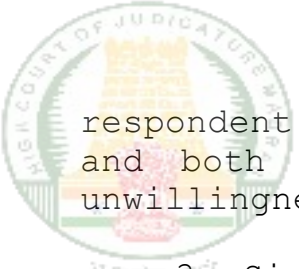
**O R D E R**

**[Order of the Court was made by R.SUBBIAH, J.]**

The petitioner, who is the mother of the detinue- Rajapriya, D/o.Arumugam, aged about 19 years, has filed the present Habeas Corpus Petition, stating that the detinue was found missing from 19.01.2017 onwards and in this regard, she has made a complaint before the second respondent. However, no effective steps were taken to trace out the detinue so far. Hence, the petitioner has come up with the present petition.

2. Today when the matter was taken up for consideration, the second respondent produced the detinue before this Court. On our enquiry, she told us that she fell in love with the third



respondent and hence, on her own volition, she went along with him and both of them got married. Furthermore, she expressed her unwillingness to go along with the petitioner.

3. Since the detinue is a major, aged about 19 years, she is set at liberty.

4. The Habeas Corpus Petition is closed as nothing survives for adjudication.
