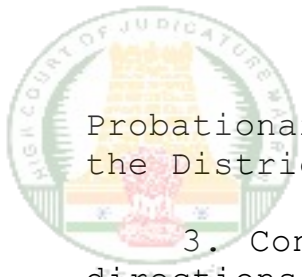

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the

3. Considering the facts of the case, we issue the following directions:

(i) The District Collector, Madurai is directed to submit a proper report as called for within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order;

(ii) On receipt of the report from the District Collector, the respondents are directed to place the matter before the Advisory Board within a period of three weeks thereafter; and

(iii) On receipt of the proposal from the Advisory Board, the Government is directed to take a decision on such proposal within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of such proposal is received from the Advisory Board.

4. With the above directions, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
