The petitioner is the mother of the detenu. It is stated in the affidavit that her daughter was given in marriage to one Veluchamy and out of the wedlock, they had two children, namely, Jeevadharsan, aged 9 years and Sanjay aged 8 years. While so, it is alleged that her daughter was found missing along with her children and in this regard a complaint has been lodged before the respondent police and a case has been registered in Crime No.7 of 2017 under Section 363 IPC and since no effective action was taken on her complaint, the petitioner is before this Court with this petition.

2. Today when the matter was taken up for consideration, the detenu were produced before this Court. On enquiry, she has stated that on her own volition, since she was having some depression, she left her matrimonial home. Now, she has stated that she is prepared to go along with the petitioner herein.



3. Recording the said submission, the Habeas Corpus Petition is closed, as nothing survives for adjudication.
