O R D E R

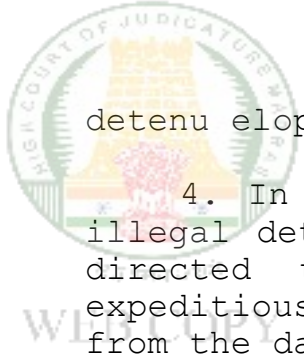
[Order of the Court was made by T.S.SIVAGNANAM, J.]

2. The complaint made by the wife of the detenu, namely, Anitha, has been registered as Crime No.53 of 2017, on the file of the third respondent police and the matter is being investigated.

In any event, the respondents are directed to investigate the case and file final report as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. The Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of on the above terms.
